Iraq Situation Report: July 31, 2014 6 ISIS gunmen have reportedly redeployed to the neighborhoods of ISIS gunmen carried out an attack with small arms and an SVEST on a Wihda and Tajnid, southern Julula. defensive position of the Jubur tribe and the IP in the Jubur village located in eastern Dhuluiya. Although ISIS has had experience in governing urban centers in Syria and Iraq before, the City of Mosul is the largest and most developed area now under ISIS control now. Aside from providing services and security, ISIS is also faced with state institutions that it will want to either dismantle or run under its own rules. The attempt to re-open the University of Mosul is one such indicator that ISIS is attempting to return life to "normal," and it will be important to watch for the way the Mosul population will react to these measures.
